




- 1. How much does it cost to register for the Ride for Children?
 - Regular Rider/Passenger \$50
 - > VIP Rider/Passenger \$250
- **2.** How do I register for the event? After going to the event website, www.rideforchildren.com, you have 3 options to get to the registration form.
 - Click on "How to get involved" in the top menu and select "Register"




Click on the "REGISTER" button in the top right hand corner of the website.




> Scroll down the page after the event details where it describes step by step how to register for the event.



- **3. How do I create a fundraising page to raise funds for Camp Boggy Creek?** <u>AFTER</u> registering for the event, you have a couple of ways to do this from the home page on the event website.
 - ➤ Follow Step 2 in the "How to Register..." section and follow the prompts.

4. What are the event details...location, schedule of the day, etc.?

5. If I am not riding a motorcycle, can I still participate in the event?

Yes, you can still participate.

However, individuals who will be joining us for the post-ride festivities only (lunch, silent & live auction, live entertainment, etc.) are <u>REQUIRED</u> to register for the event at their desired registration level (regular or VIP).

7. Can I register the day of the event?

- Yes, you can register the day of the event, however event goody bags and event swag are not guaranteed to day of registrants.
- > Online, pre-event registration will close on *Thursday, September 29 at 12:00 pm*.

8. Can I drive a car or other vehicle during the police escorted Ride?

- No, there are no other vehicle types (cars, trucks, etc.) allowed during the police escorted ride, **just motorcycles**.
- ➤ <u>All motorcycle types</u> are welcomed to participate in the Ride!

9. Can children attend the Ride for Children?

➤ We encourage all event participants to be adults 18 years or older. However if a minor child (17 years old or under) will be attending they must be accompanied by an adult and riding as a passenger on the motorcycle.

An event waiver & release must also be signed on behalf of the minor child by a parent or legal guardian.

10. Is the Ride for Children rain or shine?

The Ride for Children is a rain or shine event. If the event is canceled due to inclement weather, refunds for registration costs will not be issued.

11. Is there any specific COVID-19 instructions or protocol?

- ➤ The health and safety of all who support Camp Boggy Creek is of utmost importance. Because COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is spread by person-to-person contact, we have put in place measures recognized by health and governmental authority to increase prevention and reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, Camp Boggy Creek cannot guarantee that its participants, volunteers, partners, or others in attendance at the Ride will avoid becoming infected with COVID-19. While supporting Camp Boggy Creek by attending or participating in the Ride please consider the following statements recommended by the CDC for unvaccinated and fully vaccinated individuals.
- Vaccinated Individuals: Risk of COVID-19 is minimal for fully vaccinated individuals and the risk of transmission from fully vaccinated individuals to unvaccinated people is reduced. Therefore, fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.
- ➤ **Unvaccinated Individuals:** the CDC recommends that unvaccinated individuals continue to take prevention measures such as wearing a mask, staying 6 feet apart and practicing hand hygiene.
